Subject: Notification on the enactment of Customs Duty Act of Bhutan 2021

This is to notify that the Parliament of the Kingdom of Bhutan has revised the Customs Duty rates for goods classified in the Bhutan Trade Classification.

The Customs Duty Act of Bhutan 2021 comes into force on the day the Act is introduced by the Finance Minister in the National Assembly of Bhutan on the 20th Day of the 4th Month of the Female Iron Ox Year corresponding to the 31st Day of May 2021.

The Ministry of Finance hereby issues the rules on refund of excess Customs Duty levied as empowered by Section 187 of the Customs Act of Bhutan 2017.
