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PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

The Ministry of Finance wishes to inform the general public that the second phase of electronic Customs Management System (eCMS) is scheduled for launch in all the eight Regional Revenue and Customs Offices on 28th December 2023. Currently Agencies, business entities and individuals are utilizing eCMS for the import, export and transit of goods across the borders through an authorized Clearing and Forwarding Agents (CFA).

With the launch of the second phase of eCMS the following additional services will be available through the system

1. Temporary Import and Export	2. Refund
3. Refund Exemption	4. Appeal
5. Authorized Complaint Trader	6. Advance Ruling

To enable the Customs to expedite the clearance at the point of entry and exit, the Ministry would like to once again inform the general public regarding the need of following information;

1. For registered taxpayer with valid TPN, verify the registration details in RAMIS and make necessary amendments; and
2. If all the registration details are up to date, amend any of the following details in RAMIS once and submit for approval. This step is mandatory to push the registration details from RAMIS to eCMS.

3. All the applicants must ensure that the details updated in RAMIS are correct, especially phone number and email address for the system to share the necessary information.
4. In addition, Bhutan Integrated Revenue Management System (BIRMS) would require the traders to make applicable payment either over the counter (through cash and cheque) or through Royal Monetary Authority's (RMA) internet gateway. The current practice of using other forms of banking application like MBoB, ePay, etc will be incorporated soon.




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5. The one-time exemption issued by the Department of Revenue and Custom for import of raw materials will be discontinued with the implementation of eCMS. The traders through their CFAs are requested to submit exemption request through eCMS on consignment basis.

Further the Ministry would like to inform that with the launch of the second phase,

1. All traders will be given access to eCMS to view and print their declaration, road manifest, Letter of Guarantee and Dispatch challan.
2. The Ministry in line with Public Finance Act will be levying a nominal fee for each user as follows;
